Re: Plans for NISS Statistical Workshop

National Independent Statistical Service (NISS) has finalized plans for a Statistical Workshop to be conducted this spring at the NISS offices in Indianapolis, Indiana on Tuesday, April 14, 2015.

The workshop will include a walkthrough of the NISS website, including tutorials on the member-interactive features. The workshop will be fairly technical in nature, primarily directed to staff members that are involved in the details of data management and statistical reporting. We are attaching a detailed outline of our program for the day.

The workshop will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end no later than 4:00 p.m. There is a \$75.00 per person registration fee that will cover workshop materials and lunch. If registration is received by March 2, 2015, an "early bird" discounted rate of \$50.00 per person applies.




