Re: Assigned Risk Automobile Nonbinary Classifications – Connecticut and Vermont

AIPSO announced that the Insurance Departments of Connecticut and Vermont have all approved revisions to the private passenger automobile classifications to accommodate applicants who designate their gender as nonbinary.

For Connecticut, youthful operators with a gender selection of nonbinary will be assigned the same classification code as a youthful female.

For Vermont, youthful operators with a gender selection of nonbinary will be assigned the same classification code as a youthful male.

NISS is revising the classification charts for Assigned Risk Automobile experience in Connecticut and Vermont to reflect the above revisions, as shown on the following pages.

These changes apply to new and renewal policies effective November 1, 2020 and subsequent. The coding on the attached pages will be reflected in the 4th Quarter 2020 revisions to the NISS Automobile Volume I Statistical Plan.
