Re: Automobile Statistical Plan Volume II Coding Updated

NISS has completed a comprehensive review of the Private Passenger and Other Than Private Passenger Voluntary coding contained in our Automobile Volume II Statistical Plan and will be updating some of the coding to be consistent with industry standards. The coding changes are summarized below and shown in detail on the attached pages.

# **Voluntary Other Than Private Passenger Automobile**

- In New York:
  - o In the New Commercial Rating Program, new Truckmen Secondary Classification Codes 05 and 06 were added as follows:
    - Movers Trucking Operations 05.
    - Owned trucks, tractors and trailers that the insured leases or rents to others to use in their trucking or motor carrier operations, when the insured lessor has agreed, in writing, to provide primary coverage and to hold the lessee harmless in a written lease agreement 06.
- In New York, it is required by the New York Insurance Department regulations that all industry statistical agents must maintain and collect identical classification definitions. The New York Class codes were updated to reflect the industry standards and are shown in detail on the attached pages.

#### **Voluntary Private Passenger Automobile**

- In North Carolina:
  - o Territory Code 055 was added for any vehicle subjected to the out-of-state vehicle surcharge.

These changes apply to policies effective January 1, 2024, and subsequent. The updated coding will be reflected in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2024 revisions to the NISS Automobile Volume II Statistical Plan.

## TERRITORY CODES

Territories named herein are those adopted by NISS as outlined by the state of North Carolina. They are precisely defined in terms of contiguous ZIP codes. These NISS Territory Codes are to be used in reporting your Territory Experience.

A territory is a geographical area defined in terms of U.S. Postal Service (USPS) ZIP codes, as shown on the Territory definition pages.

Determine the applicable territory based on the ZIP code of the location of principal garaging of the vehicle. If the ZIP code of the mailing address differs from the ZIP code of the location of principal garaging, use the ZIP code of the garaging location to assign the territory.

Use **Territory Code 050 for automobiles rated** on the basis of rates outside of the state of principal garaging.

For Private Passenger automobiles, use **Territory Code 055** for any vehicle subjected to the out-of-state vehicle surcharge.
